Recruitment of Project Staff

The Climate Smart Irrigated Agriculture Project (CSIAP) implemented by the Ministry of Agriculture and funded by the World Bank is for a period of 5 years (2019 to 2024). The objective of the Project is to improve agriculture productivity via improving climate resilience agriculture in climatically vulnerable hotspot areas identified in six provinces namely North Western, North Central, Eastern, Northern, Southern and Uva. The estimated cost of the project is USD 125 Mn.

Applications are invited from citizens of Sri Lanka for the following posts in the project on a contract basis. The applicants should possess the following qualification and experience given under each category.

Agriculture Facilitator – 05 positions in Puthukudiyiruppu, Oddusuddan, Akkarayan, Mulankavil & Poonagary Agrarian Divisions in Northern Province.

Having passed G.C.E (O/L) examination in six (6) subjects with four (4) credit passes including English, Sinhala/Tamil Language and mathematics in less than two (2) sitting and

Having obtained a two-year diploma in Agriculture from a recognized institute in Sri Lanka

Having obtained a certificate of proficiency not less than the National Vocational Qualification Level 5 issued by a Technical Institute accepted by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission in the field of Agriculture.

or

A qualification recognized by the Technical Vocational Commission as an equivalent or higher than the above technical qualification

Salary

Salary for the Agriculture Facilitators are based on the Salary Code: MT1-2016 of the Public Administration Circular 03/2016 and Section 3.2.3 of the Management Services Circular No.01/2019.

Candidates those who

- Resides in the above Agrarian Service areas,
- Has experience in Agriculture practices in the dry zone, community mobilization and training
- Has a motorbike and driving license for travelling in the field **will be given preference**

A brief job description: Assist Project staff and AI on Climate Smart Agriculture (CSA) practices, mobilize farmers to adopt CSA practices, organize farmers and provide technical support to implement project activities at the field level, assist farmers to design farm plan and preparation of management plan to implement CSA practices, provide planting materials and other inputs required for farmers, collection of information on progress and project activities, assist to develop producer societies, producer associations and support marketing of products, facilitate project staff to link farmers to markets and business entities

- 2. All appointments will be initially for a period of one year and extension of services will be based on successful performance.
- 3. Employees are required to travel to other project sites depending on the need.
- 4. Working experience in foreign-funded projects in Sri Lanka is preferable
- 5. Proficiency in English, Computer Literacy and familiarity with government rules and regulations.
- 6. Salary for each position will be based on the Management Services Circular No. 01/2019 dated 05th March 2019.
- 7. Short listed applicants based on qualifications and experience will be called for the interview.
